School Educational Activities

Please find below a brief outline of the Educational Activities we offer at Greenslate Community Farm.

All of our activities can be adapted to suit specific areas of the curriculum, group sizes, needs or abilities.

Each activity runs for approximately 45 minutes to 1 hour or longer if needed, so you can choose a mix of activities and put a programme together that suit your groups needs.



<p>Plant Life Cycles Plant your own seeds and look at different stages of plant growth and the anatomy of plants Ages 5 +</p>	<p>Bug Habitats Look at bugs in their natural habitat and build a structure to encourage beneficial bugs and find out why they can be good for growing Ages 5 +</p>	<p>Animal Life Cycles Take a tour around our animals and discuss life cycles and breeds. There is also an opportunity to get up and close with our Goats and resident Hens Ages 5 +</p>
<p>Pond Dipping See how many different creatures you can catch and then try to identify them all! Ages 5 + <small>*Subject to weather / season and group sizes</small></p>	<p>Habitat Exploration Explore different types of habitats on the farm and look for signs of what may live there! Ages 9 +</p>	<p>Wild Art Collect natural materials from the farm to create your own artistic creations Ages 5 +</p>
<p>Den Building Work together as a team to build a shelter using natural materials available Ages 5 +</p>	<p>Forest Camp Create a Woodland retreat, build a camp fire and create your own woodland space to toast marshmallows Ages 5 + <small>Subject to Weather and group sizes</small></p>	<p>Fabulous Food Explore the crops on site and how they grow, learn about the types of fruit and veg and what conditions they need to succeed Ages 5 + <small>Subject to seasons</small></p>
<p>Treasure Hunt An opportunity to explore the farm and hunt down the characters using the clues you find along the way Ages 5 +</p>	<p>Orienteering Using a map and your own problem solving skills, it is a race against the clock (and the other teams) to find hidden markers around the farm Ages 11 +</p>	<p>Tree ID Head into the woods to see how many different trees you can identify and collect evidence of the creatures that might be living there Ages 11 + <small>Subject to seasons</small></p>
